WOOING WED WIDING HOOD by Charlie Lovett

Did you know that Little Red Riding Hood had two other sisters-Big Green Riding Hood and Medium Purple Riding Hood? Back in the kingdom of Wychwood-Under-Doze, Wise Prince Jason (winner of the Math Olympics and the Nobel Prize), Strong Prince Justin (who can bench press his own mother) and ordinary Loud Prince Frank all want to woo Little Red Riding Hood. So the king and queen hire the Fairy Godmother-after all, this is a fairy tale-to set three tasks for the princes to perform. Only the prince who can find the missing girl, defeat the dragon and awaken a castle visitor from her slumber earns the right to woo Wed Widing Hood that is, Red Riding Hood! Alas, Little Red's couch-potato parents don't want to lose their little girl. How else will they get their cookies delivered to Grandmother? So they hire the evil queen to thwart the Fairy Godmother's contest. Complete with the big bad wolf and more twists than a roller coaster, this fractured fairy tale adventure, easy to produce and great for audiences and performers of all ages, is guaranteed to end in happily-ever-after laughter. Gainway, Pirates of the Caribbean, here come The Lady Pirates of Captain Bree! When his crew jumps ship upon sighting the pirates in the distance, Captain Jennings is left with a makeshift crew of motley prisoners and Fergus, a sailor who can't swim, to protect his wealthy passengers, the Prescotts, from the inevitable attack. As the lady pirates take over the defenseless Kayla May, you're in for swashbuckling musical comedy with a host of hysterical characters on deck and a spectacular Bill Francoeur score. Along with Captain Bree' hearty crew of mean and nasty mates (and a couple of new recruits in training who keep forgetting to be rough and tough), you'll find the haughty Professor Bidwell and the pretentious Madam Prescott, constantly battling for special treatment and respect (ha!) from the pirates: Samuel Prescott, masquerading as a girl to avoid becoming shark bait; and Julia Prescott, bursting with desire to join the lady pirates"much to her aunt' dismay! After the pirates send Thomas, the cabin boy, out to sea with a ransom note demanding gold from the British in exchange for the Prescotts' lives, they amuse themselves by auctioning off the male prisoners to do their dirty work and showing Julia the ropes of pirating. But what is in store when Thomas returns with a British fleet, set on hanging the pirates for their deeds? Madam Prescott and Bidwell are equally set on seeing Captain Jennings hang for his defenseless approach to the lady pirates. Both your cast and your audience will love the swashbuckling ending as the two captains work together to save their crews from the British. Bill Francoeur' zesty music adds the perfect touch of authenticity to this spirited pirate play. From the suspense of "The Plank" when Professor Bidwell' life is in the pirates' hands to the belly laughs of "Shipshape and Bristol Fashion" when the pirates order the grumbling prisoners to swab the decks, your audiences will be humming the catchy sea shanties, including "Welcome Aboard!" and "They're a Nasty Lot."
